A GROWING PROBLEM – Gussie McKusick, chair of the Barnstable County Wastewater Implementation Committee, tells members of the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce last week that the 15 Cape towns are at “15 different stages” of tackling wastewater management problems prompted by unchecked. The speaker behind her, Doug Storrs of Mashpee Commons, said a “land use crime” had been committed on the Cape by zoning that makes it impossible to build traditional village centers with mixed uses. Tom Bernardo, speaker of the county Assembly of Delegates, said collaboration

among the towns is the most effective way to resolve the situation. He said there's no intention to build a giant treatment plant for the whole Cape, but instead a focus on cooperative, local solutions.
